Class 2	CHRISTMAS PUDDING STAKES: 40cm (cross poles) Assisted, including lead rein.
Class 3	SANTA STAKES: 50cm (poles and straights) Assisted, including lead rein.
Class 4	CANDY CANE STAKES: 60cm
Class 5	THE OBHPC MINI-MAJOR: 1 st Rider (14 years and under): Fences not to exceed 60cm. 2 nd Rider (over 14 years old): Fences not to exceed 90cm. Rider 1 to jump fences 1 -6 (exchange in box) Rider 2 to jump fences 7-13
Class 6	SNOWFLAKE STAKES: 70cm
Class 7	CHRISTMAS CRACKER STAKES: 80-85cm

ENTRIES

- Entries will close on Friday 22nd December. There will be no refunds after the close of entries without a vet's or doctor's certificate. Enter online at www.horse-events.co.uk
- All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee which will be stated online on a per class basis
- Late entries will be accommodated if possible please email <u>simonwhite.caroline@gmail.com</u>
- Approximate start times will be available on Wednesday 27th December 2023 at <u>www.horse-events.co.uk</u>
- All classes will be run as single phase with the second half of the course to be timed.
- Course Walks will take place prior to the start and at regular intervals throughout the day.
- No entries can be made after the start of the relevant class. All classes are open to adults and children.
- Combinations cannot take part in more than two classes per day. Horses cannot take part more than once in each class or in more than three classes on the day.
- In the event of cancellation, £5 of the entry fee will be retained to defray costs. No refunds after the closing date.
- After the relevant closing date no substitution may be made of horses or riders except in the case of illness, lameness or other unavoidable circumstances which must be certified in writing to the secretary. No substitutions once the class starts.
- If you would like to edit your horse or rider details before the closing date of the event please login to your Horse Events account and edit your booking under the 'MY BOOKING' tab.

RULES

- No lunging in the lorry park.
- No horses/ponies to be tied to trailers or lorries.
- All hay and droppings to be cleared before departure
- No dogs allowed.
- All horses and ponies must be fully vaccinated against equine flu within the past 12 months, according to the Pony Club Vaccination rules. Spot checks may be made.
- The Organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry, restrict entries and make alterations when necessary.
